

The [Centre for Economics in Paris-Saclay](#) (CEPS) and the department of Humanities and Social Sciences at [Ecole Normale Supérieure \(ENS\) Paris-Saclay](#) invites applications for a *Professeur Attaché* (Associate Professor), scheduled to start on September 1, 2025.

The position of *Professeur Attaché* is intended to be held concurrently by research fellows from French national research organizations (such as INED, INRAE, IRD, AFD, etc.) and international institutions based in Paris (OECD, Banque de France, World Bank, etc.). It consists of a 3-year contract, extendable by an additional 2 years. The teaching load is approximately 64 hours per year, in English, mainly at the graduate level, including 15 hours of student mentoring and supervision. Knowledge of French **is not required**.

Applications are invited in the field of **applied economics, with a particular emphasis on public policy evaluation, development economics, economics of inequalities, environmental economics, gender economics and/or political economy**.

The successful candidate is expected to be actively involved in the vibrant scientific life of CEPS and the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences at ENS Paris-Saclay. The annual gross salary is €7,680.
